Spring Maintenance for the Trent-Severn Waterway Bridges

Peterborough, Ontario, April 11, 2017 – In the coming weeks, Parks Canada will be conducting spring maintenance at some of our swing bridges and sites along the Trent-Severn Waterway, in preparation for the 2017 navigation season. This includes preventative maintenance tasks like washing and greasing swing bridges and conducting visual inspections to ensure their safe operability.

Temporary Bridge Closures

Parks Canada advises residents and visitors of the following temporary bridge closures for regular spring maintenance, weather permitting:

May 2, 2017	Warsaw Road Swing Bridge (Peterborough)	9:00 AM – 2:30 PM
May 3, 2017	Maria Street Swing Bridge (Peterborough)	9:00 AM – 2:30 PM
May 4, 2017	McFarlane Street Bridge (Peterborough)	9:00 AM – 2:30 PM

Traffic Delays

Seasonal maintenance on certain bridges that cross the Trent-Severn Waterway will not result in closures, but vehicles may experience short delays of about 10 minutes:
