<u>Dr. Brian F. Cumming: Kawartha Lakes Paleolimnological Study (Collection, Analysis and Age-dating of Sediment Cores): "Understanding our past to plan for the future"</u>

Dr. Brian F. Cumming: Professor of Paleolimnology and Aquatic Ecology, Paleoecological Environmental Assessment and Research Laboratory (PEARL) Queens University. Dr. Cumming's major interest is researching how ecological and environmental change occurs in lakes over decades to centuries, from both natural (e.g., climate, fires) and human-based stressors (e.g. acidic deposition, nutrient enrichment, metal deposition, etc).

This presentation will provide the preliminary results of the sediment core samples taken within the Kawartha Lake continuum.

The 2017 KLSA Annual General Meeting will be held prior to the presentation. Hear about what other residents and Lake Associations are doing to protect and enhance the Kawartha Lakes water systems.

Let's dive deep into the past to learn how to conserve our lakes for the future.
