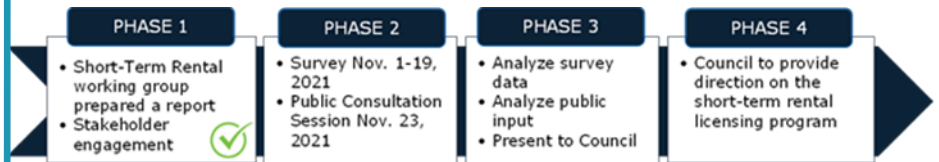

COUNCIL DECISIONS

- Approve the Public Consultation process for a proposed Short Term Rental program.



- Approve a Recreation Maintenance Policy, with level of service standards.
- Approve a staff review of the License of Occupation Policy, to assist in setting an implementation plan for summer 2022
- Approve an employee Vaccine Policy.
- Approve 2022 Council meeting calendar. Continue biweekly Tuesday meetings at 1:00 pm with simultaneous screening and recording for later viewing.
- Receive a consultant Feasibility Study reviewing options for extending the ice season at the Buckhorn Rink and request input from the Parks, Recreation and Culture Advisory Committee and the Buckhorn Community Centre.

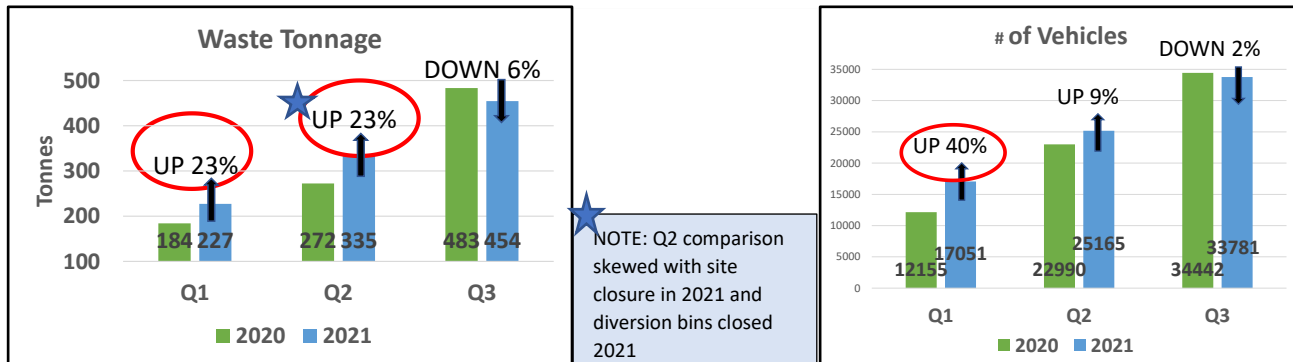


Operations Dashboard v2.

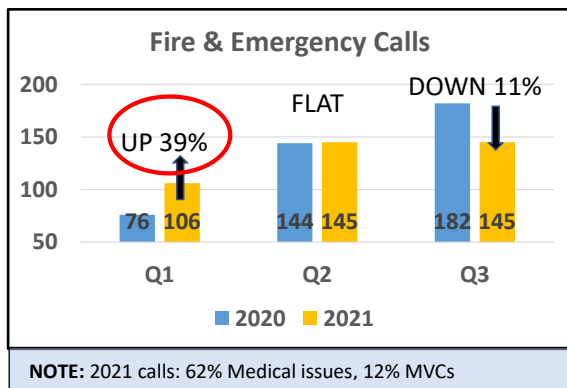

Organizational capacity and Staffing are being reviewed as part of the 2022 Budget process.

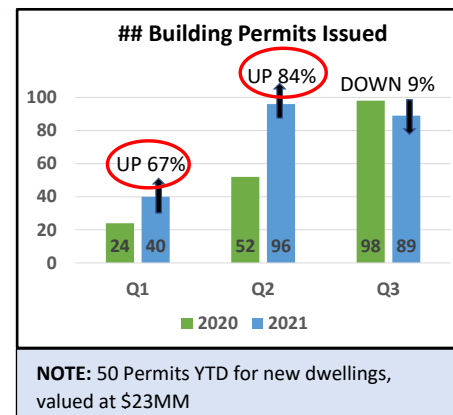

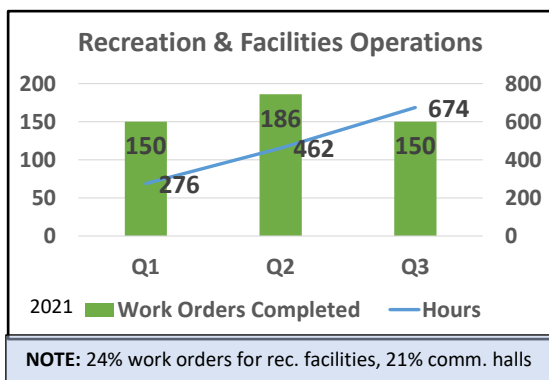

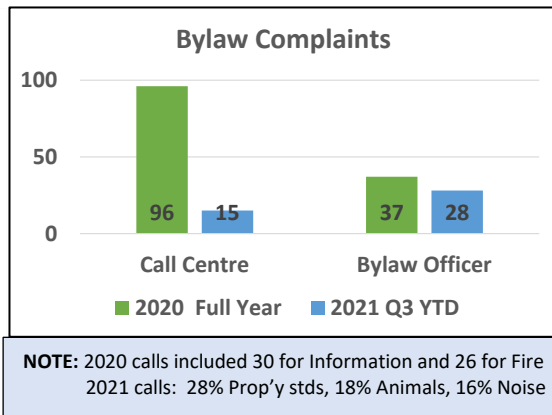
